- (a) No person shall be eligible to the office of Supreme Guardian or Associate Supreme Guardian who has not served, or who is not completing service, as an elective officer of the Executive SGC for a period of one (1) term.
- (b) No person shall be eligible to the office of Supreme Guardian or Associate Supreme Guardian, who has not previously served a full term in the office of Grand Guardian or Associate Grand Guardian of a GGC.
- (c) No Supreme Guardian or Associate Supreme Guardian shall be eligible for reelection.
- (d) No member of the SGC shall hold two (2) offices in the SGC at the same time.
- (e) No more than three (3) members of the Board of Trustees may be Past Supreme Guardians and/or Past Associate Supreme Guardians.
- (f) Any member of the Board of Trustees, having served the term for which she/he was elected, or who resigns from that office for any reason, shall be ineligible for election or reelection to the Board of Trustees until one (1) year after her/his term has expired. This does not apply to members appointed by the Supreme Guardian to fill vacancies.
- (g) A member of the SGC serving as a member of the Board of Trustees shall not be eligible for an elective office of the SGC until she/he has completed, or is completing, the term for which she/he was elected.

- (c) Past Bethel Guardians and Past Associate Bethel Guardians for Bethels under Supreme who are voting delegates may be eligible to serve as appointed officers in the Supreme Guardian Council. No more than three (3) appointed offices shall be appointed from Bethels under Supreme Jurisdictions.

- (d) Election shall be from members present, except in case of sickness or other unavoidable circumstance, when candidates may be excused by a majority vote of the members present.

This will be the only opportunity a candidate will have to give this background to the body.
 - (3) Those choosing not to file a “Letter of Intent,” or those who miss the deadline, will still be eligible to aspire to the position on the day of elections.
 - (4) Any “Letter of Intent” received by the deadline will be printed alphabetically by last name of the interested party and distributed to the Voting Delegates at the Annual Session of the SGC.

**ARTICLE I
NAME**

Section 1.

- (a) The name of this organization shall be the Job’s Daughters Masonic Degree team of the (state/province/department/district) of _____

**ARTICLE II
PURPOSE**

Section 1.

- (a) The sole purpose of this organization is to initiate, pass and/or raise the father, brother, husband, son, grandson or other close male relative of a Member or Majority Members of Job’s Daughters into a regular Masonic Lodge.

Section 2.

- (a) This organization shall function under the Supreme Guardian Council for jurisdictions under Supreme, the Grand Guardian Council for jurisdictions under Grand, and Jurisdictional Guardian Councils for the jurisdiction in which it is located.

Section 3.

- (a) No indebtedness shall be incurred by the Job’s Daughters Masonic Degree Team in excess of the funds in its treasury, unless written consent has been obtained from the executive members of the respective SGC, GGC or JGC.

Section 4.

- (a) At such time as it is proven that the organization is no longer functioning or requests to be disbanded, this organization may be disbanded by the Supreme Guardian or Grand Guardian under whose jurisdiction it functions.

Section 5.

- (a) If the organization is disbanded, all rights and title to its monies and properties shall be vested in the SGC,GGC, or the JGC under which it has functioned.

**ARTICLE III
MEMBERSHIP AND FINANCE**

Section 1.

- (a) The membership of this organization shall consist of Master Masons who are current council members of a Bethel or Past Associate Bethel Guardians who are willing to abide by and conform to the policies as described in Article II above and who are current CAVs in all jurisdictions requiring CAV certification.

Section 2.

- (a) Any and all fees required by membership in this organization shall be borne by its members.

**ARTICLE IV
OFFICERS**

Section 1.

- (a) The officers of this organization shall be the Vice Associate Supreme Guardian, the Vice Associate Grand Guardian, or Vice Associate Jurisdictional

Guardian in the respective jurisdiction and a Senior Warden.

- (b) The Vice Associate Supreme Guardian shall appoint a deputy to serve locally for areas under Supreme.

**ARTICLE V
DUTIES OF OFFICERS**

Section 1. The Vice Associate Supreme Guardian or his deputy, the Vice Associate Grand Guardian, or the Vice Associate Jurisdictional Guardian

- (a) Shall be responsible for informing the Grand Lodge of their jurisdiction that this Degree Team exists.
- (b) That upon request the request of a Daughter or Majority member he notify the Master of the Petitioner’s Lodge and request of the Master permission to perform the requested degree.

Section 2. The Senior Warden Shall be responsible for:

- (a) Assembling and maintaining of the corps of Master masons for the Job’s Daughters Masonic Degree Team in sufficient numbers and proficiency to perform any requested degree.
- (b) Assembling a slate of officers for the requested degree.
- (c) Shall designate a team member to serve as Master for the slate who will be in charge of the specified degree.

**ARTICLE VI
MEETINGS**

Section 1.

- (a) There shall be an organizational meeting at each annual convocation of the jurisdiction.
- (b) The business of such a meeting shall consist of the appointment of the Senior Warden by the presiding officer, processing applications to join the team and evaluating the proficiency of each applicant.

Section 2.

- (a) While conducting a degree at a Lodge, all JDMDT members attending shall conform to the accepted dress codes of the Jurisdiction and the Lodge.
- (b) Unless prohibited by the jurisdiction’s Grand Lodge, a degree team member should wear a JDMDT apron while conducting a Degree Team Degree.
- (c) This apron shall be obtained form an Official Job’s Daughters supplier.

**ARTICLE VII
DONATIONS**

Section 1.

- (a) Should a donation be made in honor of the Job’s Daughters Masonic Degree Team, all checks shall be made payable to the SGC, GGC, or JGC and annotated “Donation, JDI degree team”.
